

Highland Hurricanes

June 18 – 19, 2010

SANCTION: This meet is sanctioned by USA Swimming and Indiana Swimming. Sanction Number IN10327.

HOST: Highland Hurricanes Swim Club, Inc.

LOCATION: Highland High School, 9135 Erie Street, Highland, Indiana 46322.

FORMAT: Current USA Swimming and Indiana Swimming rules will govern this meet.

USA Swimming Rules 202.3.2 - At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee shall assist the athlete in making arrangements for such supervision.

EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2009, the competitor must wear only one swimsuit in one or two pieces except as provided in USA Swimming Rule 205.10.1. All swimsuits shall be made of textile materials. For men, the swimsuit shall not extend above the navel nor below the knees, and for women, shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulder, nor extend below the knee.

**ENTRY
DEADLINE:**

Entries will be accepted starting Friday, May 14, 2010. Entry deadline will be 10 p.m. on Friday, June 4, 2010. **NO TELEPHONE ENTRIES.** We will extend the deadline if the meet is not full. Method for entries is a Hy-Tek Meet Manager file for entries on 3.5" disk with hard copies. **EMAIL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.** E-mail the entry file to: jdtuskan@sbcglobal.net. The email entry must be followed up by a hard copy of the entry information, and submission of the hard copy prior to the final date would be appreciated. Entries will be accepted primarily in the order that they are received, but the number of officials provided by a club will also be considered. No teams will be broken, but entries will be limited to keep within the 4-hour rule. We will notify teams being turned away by phone or e-mail within 72-hours after the meet entry deadline, or 72- hours after meet becomes full, whichever comes first.

FEES: \$1.50 per swimmer Indiana Swimming Athlete Surcharge, \$2.50 per

Individual Event, & \$5.00 per Relay Team. Fees must accompany entry forms. Please make **ONE** check payable to **HHSC**. Entry fees for scratched events are non-refundable. **Deck Entries will be allowed if the meet is not full and the swimmer is already entered in the meet (\$5.00 per individual entry, &10.00 per relay entry).**

Please report to the computer table to submit and pay for deck entries before positive-check-in ends. A receipt will be given to the person deck entering and it must be kept to verify your entry.

ENTRY FORMAT: The following must be submitted by the entry deadline:

- Hy-Tek Meet Manager file for entries. A printed copy of the entry must also accompany the file. All times must be completed to the hundredth of a second. NT times will be accepted
- Team Roster with each swimmer's current USA Swimming number. This can be done in Team Manager as a report. Unattached swimmers must be entered independently of attached swimmers
- Completed team summary report (included in this packet)
- Completed relay entry sheet (included in this packet) this can be done in TM
- Executed release and hold harmless agreement (included in this packet)
- **Officials Volunteer Sheet**
- 1 check for payment of all entry fees made payable to **HHSC**

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- **Data on disk must be consistent with the data on the print out(s).**
- **Unattached swimmers must be entered independently of attached swimmers.**
- Teams not submitting entries on diskette or email entry file will be charged a \$50 Administration Fee

ENTRY LIMITATIONS:

Swimmers will be limited to 5 individual events and 2 relays per day. Entries will be limited to keep within the 4-hour rule; refunds will be issued if events are limited. However, no teams will be broken.

ELIGIBILITY:

Swimmer(s) must be registered with USA Swimming to be accepted into this meet. Age as of **June 18th, 2010** will determine the swimmer's age for the entire meet. USA Swimming registration numbers must accompany the entry.

CHECK IN:

This is a **POSITIVE SIGN-IN MEET**. Positive sign-in means, "I'm here. I intend to swim." To sign-in positively, circle the swimmer's name on sign-in sheets. Sign-in sheets will be posted 30 minutes before the start of warm-ups for each session. The **deadline for positive sign-in will be 30 minutes before the scheduled start for each session.** At that deadline, the sheets will be removed from the table and no changes or

corrections will be accepted. Any swimmer scratched under this rule may present to the Referee at least 2 minutes before the start of the slowest heat of the missed event and request to swim in an empty lane. The Referee will honor such requests on a first come, first serve basis and only to the extent empty lanes are available.

SCRATCH RULE: The Indiana Swimming "Scratch Rule" will not be in effect for this meet.

CLERK OF COURSE: This invitational will be seeded (i.e., cardless) for all age groups. For swimmers 9 years and older, lane and heat assignments will be posted at various points around the pool and hallways. For swimmers 8 years and under, a standard clerk of course will be operated during the Friday session and the Saturday morning session. However, positive sign-in is a requirement for all age groups. We highly encourage coaches to cover check-in, scratch and meet procedures with their new swimmers and parents. **Absolutely no parents will be allowed on the pool deck.** This is a requirement of USA Swimming.

FINAL RESULTS: One complimentary copy will be provided to each club entering 5 or more swimmers. Additional copies may be requested.

FACILITY: 6 lane, 25-yard pool with starting blocks for competition, with additional space for continual warm-up and warm-down. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). Pool depth ranges from 14 feet to 4.5 feet. Daktronic timing with two (2) back up timers per lane. Keifer non-turbulent lane markers. Adjacent locker rooms.

COACHES: Information packets will be distributed to the club coach upon their arrival at the meet. An Officials meeting will be held 30 minutes before the start of each session. Coaches **MUST** constantly display their USA Swimming coach credentials to gain access to the pool deck. The meet referee reserves the right to ask for coach credentials, display and/or deny deck access if the coach does not comply.

SCORING: We will be scoring the top 12 individual places in the following age groups: 7 & Under, 8 Yr. Old, 9 Yr. Old, 10 Yr. Old, 11 Yr. Old, 12 Yr. Old, 13 Yr. Old, 14 Yr. Old, 15 & Over. 13 & Over swimmers will swim together but will be scored separately. The top 6 relay places be scored in the following age groups: 8 & Under, 9-10 Yr. Old, 11-12 Yr. Old, and 13 & Over. Scoring will be as follows:

Individual events:	16-13-12-11-10-9-7-5-4-3-2-1
Relays:	32-26-24-22-20-18

AWARDS: **Individual Events:** We will award ribbons to the first 12 places in each age group.

Individual High Point Trophies: will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place to girls and boys in each age group.

Relays: 1st through 3rd medals.

Team High Point Trophies: will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places.

CONCESSIONS: Refreshments will be available in the Pool Class Room on Friday and Saturday.

NOTES: **ONLY COACHES AND PARTICIPATING OFFICIALS ARE ALLOWED ON THE POOL DECK. NO FOOD IS ALLOWED ON THE POOL DECK. SMOKING IS NOT PERMITTED ANYWHERE IN HIGHLAND HIGH SCHOOL.**
